blossoms of the trees along the walkway and the frequency of the stamping rubbish eater trucks it is also not to forget about climate infrastructure opening hours term times parking meters time tables growing shadows and moon light but most of all it is about how all this is experienced by citizens on a daily basis and how they navigate within this complex structure of patterns the content of this book is based on the content of the urbantick blog between 2008 2010 one year blogging about this topic brought together a large collection of different aspects and thoughts it is not at all a conclusive view the opposite might be the case it is an exploratory work in progress while trying to capture as many facets of the topic as possible
